Aim and Context of the Project

HANDS AROUND THE WORLD was founded in 1994 by Dr. David Steiner, who for many years lived and worked as a doctor in general practice in Jersey. He became involved with the States of Jersey Overseas Aid Programme, during which time the plight of many people in developing countries came to be of great personal concern. The Jersey branch of HANDS AROUND THE WORLD (HATW) was established in 2007 from a group of HATW supporters. We have our own Trustees and have developed strong links with partners overseas.
