

How to apply to join a Volunteer Project


STEP 1: Registration

If you already have a username and password, please login and skip to step 2.

Please click on the Apply here button



PLEASE NOTE: You must be over 18 and a Jersey Resident to apply.

Please complete the contact information on the registration form. Once this is submitted you will receive a registration email containing your username and temporary password to access our Smartsimple system ready to apply for a volunteer project.


Please note, it may take up to five minutes for the username and password to be sent to your email address. Please check your junk/spam folders if your registration email does not appear directly into your inbox.

STEP 2: Apply for a volunteer project


You should now have a username and password to login to SmartSimple (https://joa.smartsimpleuk.com/).

For security reasons, you may be asked for a verification code the first time you login. The verification code will be automatically sent to your email address.


Once you have logged into the system, you will be directed to your dashboard.



Select **volunteering opportunities** and then click the 'Apply now' tab. Select the volunteer project you wish to apply for and fill out all the information requested on each of the three tabs and submit.
